The LISMS counts both accomplished modelers and neophytes in our ranks -- of all ages and interests. When we're not building, buying or talking plastic, we're out promoting the hobby and history in miniature. This club runs children's learning clinics, supports air shows and configures displays at shops, exhibits, museums and libraries. Each spring, the LISMS hosts one of the tri-state's largest hobby shows, appropriately titled "**RepLicon**", and caps the year with special holiday events.
